



Melville High School Bus Registration 2016

This Code of Conduct is between _____ (student),
 of _____ (home address)
 (Phone Number) _____ and **Go-Bus** (bus operator), and **Melville High School** (school).

The caregiver and the student should ensure they have read and understand this document, which is to be adhered to for the safety of the bus driver and all students travelling on the school bus.

I, _____ (student), agree to abide by the behavioural expectations outlined below:

- I live more than 4.8 km from **Melville High School (and Melville High School is my closest High School) and within the TEZ (See Map), Bus Route** _____
- I will not eat on the bus
- I will not throw anything inside or out of the bus.
- I will respect other students and their property at all times (this includes pushing, verbal or physical abuse, or any other behaviour that may distract the driver).
- I will use socially acceptable language when conversing with the driver and/or other students and I will not speak at a volume that may distract the driver. I will observe the instructions of the bus driver.
- I understand that any damage I cause to the bus will result in my caregiver being billed for the cost of repairs.
- I will not engage in any behaviour that could put the driver or other students at risk.
- If travelling on a school bus, I will be attending school on that day.
- I will be in full school uniform, excluding Year 13 students (unless it is a Mufti Day or Field Trip day).
- When travelling on a school bus, I must always carry a bus pass and have it available to show the driver/bus controller at any time. **(no pass – no ride)**

The safety and comfort of everyone on the bus depends on a standard of behaviour and consideration for others that is expected in the classroom. We hope that caregivers will support the school in maintaining these standards of behaviour and safety.

IF THIS CODE OF CONDUCT IS BROKEN:

- *The student is given an oral warning by Bus Controller (details of misconduct will be made clear to the student).*
- *If there is no improvement, further action will be taken. The Deputy Principal will be informed. Contact will be made with caregiver and the student may be banned from travelling on the school bus for a period of time (maximum of a school week). The Caregiver will be required to find alternate transport to get the student to school.*
- *In extreme cases of misbehaviour or gross misconduct, Step 2 above will be enforced immediately and the privilege of travelling on a school bus will be withdrawn immediately.*

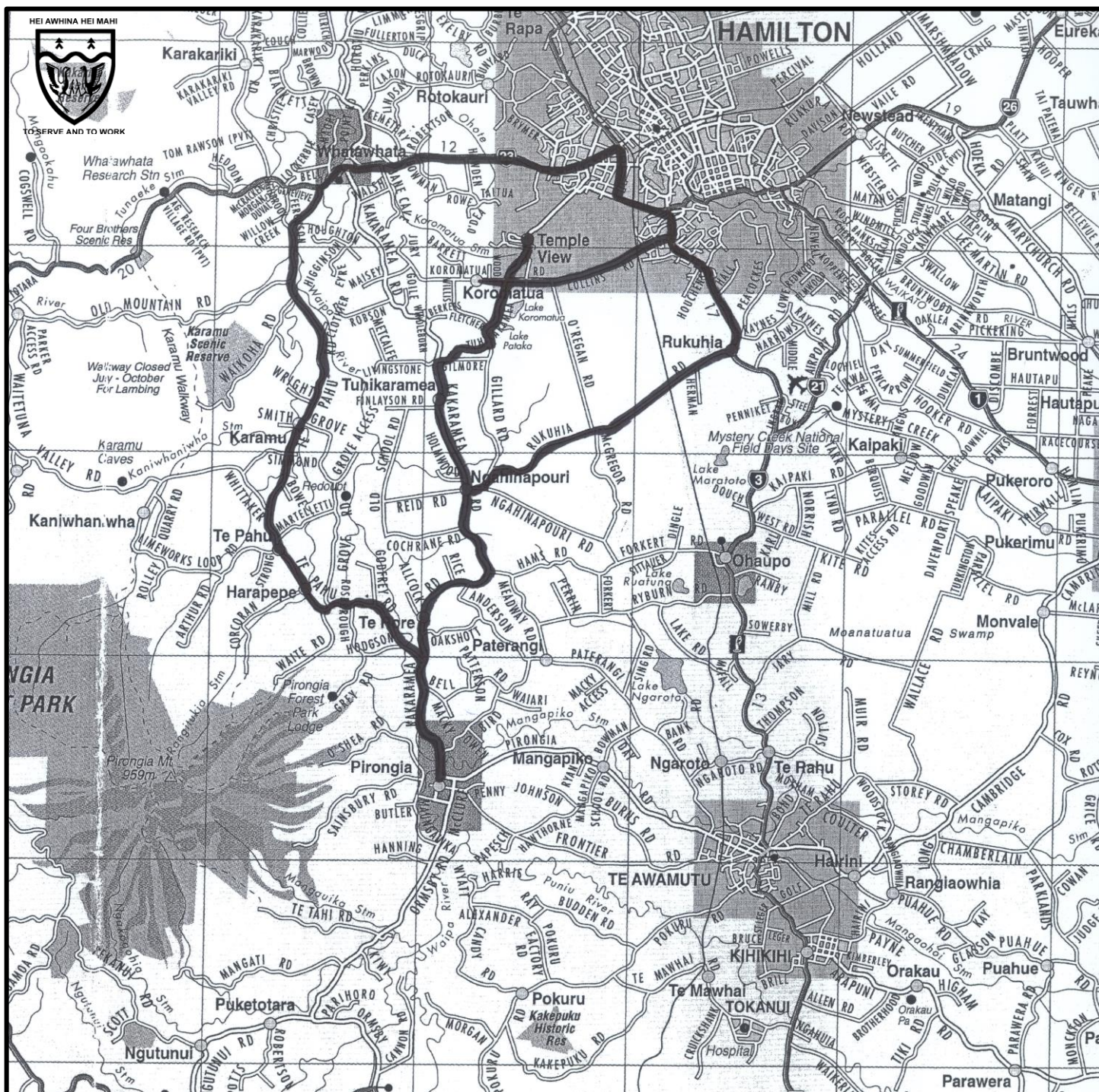
