Uniform requirements Years 9 - 12



Melville High School believes that wearing school uniform correctly encourages a sense of pride in oneself and the school. Our students represent our school in our community. The look our students give outside of the school is what determines the public perception of our school. We want all Melville High School students to reflect the school in a positive light in the wider Melville community.

All students are required to wear regulation school uniform and be well-groomed at all times, including to and from school. Students not in correct school uniform may be sent home or withdrawn from class.

Wearing uniform correctly means ...

- It will be clean, tidy, unmarked and in good condition.
- Items with long sleeves will be worn with sleeves pulled down.
- Shoes must be clean.
- T-shirts must not show below polo shirts and jackets.

Suitable grooming means ...

- Hair must be neat, tidy and groomed with safety in mind
- Hair styles must be conservative in cut and colour.
- Clips, combs, hair-ties and headbands should be unobtrusive and plain green, red or white.
- Students must be clean-shaven at all times.

Thank you for your assistance and for checking your son or daughter when s/he leaves for school and returns home each day.

GIRLS UNIFORM

BLOUSE: **Regulation** white cotton button through blouse; **OR**
Regulation white cotton polo shirt

SKIRT: **Regulation** black

SHORTS: **Regulation** black

SOCKS: **Plain** black

STOCKINGS: Winter: **Plain** black pantyhose

BOYS UNIFORM

SHIRT: **Regulation** white cotton polo

SHORTS: **Regulation** black

TROUSERS: **Regulation** long black

SOCKS: **Plain** black

BOYS and GIRLS UNIFORM

<u>JERSEY</u>	Regulation	PE Uniform Dress Code Years 9 and 10: Regulation green top and red shorts
<u>JACKET</u>	Regulation black	
<u>SHOES</u>	Plain black. No other coloured markings. Lace up shoes must have black laces. Black sandals only, must have back heel strap. No jandals/boots.	
<u>SOCKS</u>	Plain black [worn with shoes only] or Plain black pantyhose	
<u>SKIVVY / TOP</u>	A plain white long sleeved top/skivvy only may be worn under regulation polo top or blouse.	
<u>JEWELLERY</u>	Wristwatch, plain ear studs/sleepers in ears only (ONE set only)	
<u>HAIR</u>	Male students must be clean shaven. Hair should be clean and tidy. No extreme hairstyle/colour – Principal's discretion.	
<u>HATS</u>	Regulation black bucket hats or caps. NO beanies.	
<u>SCARVES</u>	Plain white, green or black. Multi-coloured scarves are not allowed.	
<u>MAKE-UP:</u>	Students may only wear a minimal amount of make-up to school.	

The regulation uniform is essentially the same and is clearly identifiable with the school crest or monogram woven into the item.

From January 2017 **ALL** students are required to wear the new regulation uniform. Remember that white business shirts are not part of the school uniform from 2017. If there are any issues about uniform, please contact Steph Ashton (AP): ast@melville-high.school.nz
